Election of Council 2025 - 2027

The Hong Kong Association of Critical Care Nurses Ltd. (HKACCN Ltd.) will conduct the 2025–2027 Council Election and is now calling for nomination. It is hoped that members will encourage serving or potential nurse leaders in the field to stand for the election, especially those who have interest and experience in committee work. Nomination forms will be available at the Association or from our web site. I would like to draw your attention to the following main features:

- 1. According to the constitution, 13 to 15 council members will be elected bi-annually. Only life members/ full members who have worked in critical care areas or in the management, teaching or research of critical care are entitled to be elected.
- 2. The candidate who stands for election must be a currently paid-up full member/life member of the Association and must be nominated by 2 paid-up full members/life members of HKACCN Ltd.
- 3. A full member/ life member may nominate more than one candidate, but not more than the stipulated number of vacancies. According to the constitution, each council member will serve for a term of 2 years and will be eligible for re-election. There will be 15 vacancies in this election.
- 4. The elected candidate will be invited to serve the Association as council member on a voluntary basis starting from 22nd November 2025 to the date of Annual General Meeting in 2027.

6. To ensure better representation, candidates will be elected from our full and life members in this election. They are expected to be interested in the advancement and betterment of the nursing profession in Hong Kong. They are elected on their personal integrity and leadership in the nursing profession rather than representation of their working organizations. To have even distribution of council members in the nursing field, it is desirable to have not more than two seats of the council occupied from the same working area.

7. Election Guidelines

- 7.1 15 vacancies are to be filled by candidates with the highest numbers of votes in this election. If two or more candidates have the same number of votes for one vacancy. The president of the council will have the casting vote.
- 7.2 If an elected candidate leaves the office after accepting the official appointment offered. The timing and method of the vacancy replacement will be decided by the council.
- 7.3 The incumbent candidates will take office for 2 years.
- 7.4 The completed nomination forms have to be received by the Association on or before 17:00, 30th September 2025.

7.5 Ballot paper shall be prepared if the number of eligible candidates is more

than 15.

7.6 All Life Members and Full Members have the right to vote. Each voting

Member shall have one vote.

8. To ensure openness and fairness of the election, 2 observers who are full

member/life member of the Association will be invited to join the counting of

ballots.

9. The list of newly elected candidates will be announced in the coming Annual

General Meeting on 21st November 2025 and posted in the latest issue of the Hong

Kong Association of Critical Care Nurses' Newsletter.

Please participate actively in election and identify appropriate nurses to serve the

Association and work for the critical care nurses in Hong Kong.
